

Implementation of Section 26 of the Right to Information Act, 2005

For the implementation of Section 26 of The Right to Information Act, 2005 and Imparting training and awareness to its employees, NALCO has taken adequate measures like:

Regularly developing and organizing educational programs, training sessions, workshops to impart the understanding of the employee as to how to exercise the rights contemplated under this Act and promote timely and effective dissemination of accurate information by public authorities about their activities; especially training its nodal officers and employees by providing relevant and easily comprehensible guides and training materials to them, for making them understand the various provisions of the Act , its objectives and its crucial aspects.

During FY 2021-22, from 28th to 29th June 2021, 30 employees including both executives and non-executives were imparted training on RTI Act and from 27th to 29th January 2022, 13 employees including both executives and non-executives were imparted training on RTI Act with the faculty support of Principal Director, Institute of Public Administration, Bangalore, and on 28th June 2021, 05 executives imparted training on RTI Act 2005 through Institute of Good Governance, New Delhi and from 7th to 8th October, 2021 05 executives imparted training on RTI Act 2005 through IBC Mumbai .So far till FY 2021-22, training has been imparted to 314 employees including both executives and non-executives On RTI Act.
