- 1. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023

  OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.
- 3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:
  - i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
  - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.

- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

# Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions/क्रेता द्वारा जोड़ी गई बिड की विशेष शर्तें

### 1. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

### 2. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

### 3. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

### 4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- a) **No. of SETS:** Total requirement is for 150 SETS.
- b) <u>Supply instructions</u>: Material should be supplied in the form of complete sets which contains 11 ite ms and to be used on set basis. Each set consists of items and its respective quantities as mentioned a bove. Comparison of rates therefore shall be made for total price against each set constituting individu

al item and quantity as above. In case of order, the supplier is required to offer the material in sets for Pre-Despatch Inspection (PDI) of individual item in multiples of the quantity required against each set as stated above. All the Flue Wall Bricks should be embossed with identification marks with size and su pplier's name for easy identification. Mortar and Calcined Bauxite should be supplied in polythene line d HDPE bags and then in wooden pallets to avoid any transit damage. For details please Refer ANNEX URF-A.

- c) **Delivery period:** The required quantity shall be supplied on FOR NALCO, Smelter Plant site stores ba sis @ of 25 sets in every month and within a gap of 30 days. Bidders shall confirm to the above point s pecifically. The quantity and the delivery date may change as per the requirement of NALCO. The com mencement of supply of 1<sup>St</sup> lot will be done within 35 days from the date of LOI/Purchase Order. Howe ver for any new vendor, who have till date not supplied to NALCO an additional time relaxation of 15 d ays will be given to them only on commencement of 1st lot for mould preparation. For these category of vendor commencement of supply of 1<sup>St</sup> lot will be done within 50 days from the date of LOI/Purchas e Order. For remaining lots supply has to be made @25 sets in every month and within a gap of 30 day
- d) Test Certificate: Testing of the Bricks, Mortar & Calcined Bauxite etc. shall be done according to the I atest version of IS- standards and as stipulated in ANNEXURE-A. Test certificates confirming to NALCO' s Specification shall be submitted along with the dispatch documents as well as during the pre-dispatc h inspection.
- e) Inspection/Sampling/Packing: Pre-Despatch Inspection (PDI) shall be carried out by the authorized representative of NALCO at your works and the required inspection facilities shall be provided by suppl ier. Supplier has to inform NALCO 15 days in advance to depute NALCO's technical representative for P DI at supplier's works. Bidder has to mention clearly on the offer about place of works where PDI will b e carried out by NALCO. If the offered materials are not ready for inspection during the visit of NALCO's representative, the expenditure of the inspector for that lot will be deducted from any bill of the suppli er. PDI call against each lot should accompany with manufacturer's test certificate. However, final insp ection will be done by NALCO at NALCO site after receipt and completion of the supplies against each I ot and the result will be binding on the supplier. The vendor has to provide a certificate to the effect th at the inspected & accepted materials during PDI have been dispatched. Mortar and Calcined Bauxite will be tested at NALCO's Site after receipt of materials against each lot. Following points are applicabl e over PDI:
  - If the offered quantities at vendor's work during inspection are less than the mentioned in PDI call letter, the total expenditure borne by NALCO during that inspection tour shall be deducted from any of the bill submitted by the vendor.
  - If the material fails to confirm the PO specification during PDI in two consecutive occasion i.e. during two continuous PDI, the expenditure borne by NALCO, during that two inspection tour, s hall be deducted from any of the bill submitted by the vendor.
  - The Supplier has to provide/submit the internal Test Certificate of the Material at least 5 days before the PDI date, subsequent to which Nalco may verify the availability/stock of the materia Is any time before the PDI date through Video call & if the stock of the material does not matc h with the offered gtv. the vendor has to give revise PDI call.
  - NALCO will complete PDI within 07-10 days from the date of receipt of official PDI call.

Detailed Instruction on PDI/Sampling/Packing is provided at Annexure - A. These instruction will be strictly followed for PDI/Sampling/Packing for all the items/lots.

EMD and security deposit will be applicable as per clause no. 7 and 16 respectively of commercial che cklist Annexure-III.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
