#### **Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions**

- 1. OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration
- 2. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
  - 1. The party has to submit requisite EMD along with bid document.
  - 2. The job is to be awarded two agencies in the ratio of 55:45%.
  - 3. The party has to submit hard copy of Litigation History (in original) along with bid document.
  - 4. The bidder should fill-up sign and seal Annexure of NIT and submit the same along with the bid do cuments for consideration and further acceptance.
  - 5. The bidder should comply with all the relevant documents (attested by NOTARY PUBLIC) as per NI T PQC.
  - 6. The applicable GST rate for this contract is 18%. The items rates/amount must be quoted by the bidder in format as available in the GeM Portal including GST @ 18%.
  - 7. The party has convert this EXCEL sheet to PDF and upload the same in GeM portal at the Financial break up location.


- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.

- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.


- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
