Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if bidder submits valid Udyam Registration certificate.	As per OM ref. 1(3)/2018-MA, Part-III dt. 25.03.2022 of GOI, FAQ No. 18, MSE Purchase preference <b>shall not</b> be applicable in this case.  <b>Hence MSE purchase preference clause written anywhere in the tender stands withdrawn.</b>

The exemption for submitting EMD may be considered only if copies of a valid Registration Certificate for the product and other supporting documents is submitted along with the offer.For the tenders, which are invited electronically through CPPP, Participating MSE vendors are required to declare their Udyam Registration Number (or as per notification) in CPPP, failing which such bidders shall not be exempted from deposit of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
