India Trims Gas-based Power Capacity by 20% to 20.1 GW

New Delhi: India has reduced gas-based power generation capacity by 20% or 5 GW in the last three months to 20.13 GW as of April. The development comes at a time when the government has issued a directive to use unutilised gas-based generation capacity to ensure uninterrupted power supply during the summer season, when projected demand is expected to hit 277 GW.

According to Central Electricity Authority (CEA) data, India's overall installed power generation capacity was 472.468 GW in April, while the share of gas-based capacity was at 20.13 GW.

The power ministry has decided to use unutilised gas-based electricity generation capacity to ensure uninterrupted power supply and maintain grid security amid an anticipated rise in the demand this summer.

The ministry has been taking steps to ensure uninterrupted power supply and meet the projected or anticipated peak power demand of 277 GW this summer season. Peak power demand had touched an all-time high of 250 GW in May 2024. The peak power demand was

about 235 GW in March and April,

while it was 238 GW in February

The ministry has issued fresh directions, invoking Section 11 of the Electricity Act, "to ensure maximum generation from gas-based power plants" in the country to meet the rise in peak demand, particularly during non-solar hours.

Mango Row: Maharashtra Govt Agency Says **US Inspectors Skipped Standard Procedures**

Pune | New Delhi: Following rejection of 15 consignments of Indian mangoes by the US due to procedural lapses, the Indian authorities have claimed that the American inspectors did not follow the protocol.

"Instead of discussing the matter with relevant agencies or notifying the facility beforehand, they (the inspectors) directly reported the alleged issues to their senior offices in the US, resulting in the rejection of the 15 consignments," Maharashtra State Agricultural Marketing Board (MSAMB), a government arm housing an irradiation facility in Mumbai, said in a statement on Tuesday. It further said that had the American inspectors flagged

the issues to facility officials prior to issuing PPQ203-a mandatory document for US-bound mangoes-"the losses could have been avoided.'

The state agency also confirmed that the US authorities had rejected a total of 25 metric tonnes of mangoes from 10 exporters—all irradiated on May 8

ET was first to report about the rejection of Indian mango shipments in multiple American airports, including Los Angeles, San Francisco and Atlanta. The affected mango consignments

were irradiated— a mandatory treatment that exposes the fruit to controlled doses of radiation to eliminate pests-at the MSAMB-operated facility in Navi Mumbai. The process was carried out under the supervision of an officer deputed by the US Department of Agriculture (USDA).

These mangoes, including Alphonso, Kesar, Banganapalli and Himayat are now being sold in the US market.

certified by the management as on reporting date, the effect of which is not material.

3. The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 13th November 2024 has approved interim dividend of ₹ 4/- per equity share (80% on face value of ₹ 5/- each) amounting to ₹ 734.65 crore for the FY 2024-25 which was paid on 11th December, 2024. PNB Investment Services Ltd (Debenture Trustee) and GNAL (issuer) wherein the sponsors (promoters) have granted mandatory put option and accelerated put option to the investor and retained accelerated buyout option and mandatory buyout option. The Deemed Investment amount of ₹ 147.36 crore which includes, ₹ 124.15 crore towards fair value of Financial Liability against these CCDs and ₹ 23.21 crore towards financial guarantee provided without charging any consideration from the joint venture.

1. The financial results have been reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee at the meeting held on 21st May, 2025 and approved by the Board of Directors in its meeting held on 21st May, 2025. The annual Financial Results have been audited by the Joint Statutory Auditors of the Company as required under regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.

The Company has four Joint Venture companies namely-1. Ws. Angul Aluminium Park Pvt. Limited, 2. M/s. GACL-NALCO Alkalies & Chemicals Private Limited, 3. M/s. Khanij Bidesh India Limited, 4. M/s. Utkarsha

Aluminium Dhatu Nigam Limited. Out of the four joint venture companies whose financials have been consolidated, financials of M/s. Angul Aluminium Park Pvt. Limited, has been consolidated on the basis of financials as certified by the management as on reporting date, the effect of which is not material.

The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 13th November 2024 has approved interim dividend of ₹ 4/- per equity share (80% on face value of ₹ 5/- each) amounting to ₹ 734.65 crore for the FY 2024-25 which was paid on 11th December, 2024. The 2 not interim dividend of ₹ 4 per equity share (80% on face value of ₹ 5/- each) amounting to ₹ 734.65 crore for the FY 2024-25 has been approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held

on 10th February, 2025 which was paid on 7th March, 2025.

Based on the recommendation of the Board, the shareholders of the Company has approved final dividend of ₹ 2/- per equity share (40% on face value of ₹ 5/- each) amounting to ₹ 367.33 crore for the FY 2023-24 at 43rd Annual General Meeting held on 27th September, 2024 and the same was paid on 24th October, 2024. The total dividend pay out for the FY 2023-24 is ₹ 5.00 per equity share (interim dividend of ₹ 3.00/-per share and final

dividend of ₹ 2/- per share) amounting to ₹ 918.32 crore. 5. The Company has not recognised the revenue from its two wind power plants (WPP) located in the State of Rajasthan due to non execution of fresh Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) since 01.04.2019 and such issue is being subjudice before Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan based on writ petition filed by the Company. In view of long pending disputes for execution of PPA, impairment of WPPs at Ludharva and Devikot at Rajasthan carried out earlier has been reassessed and impairment loss of ₹ 79.44 crore has been reversed during the quarter. Similarly, due to non execution of PPA for WPP-Gandikota, Andhra Pradesh, power generated is wheeled to

6. During the year, M/s. GACL-NALCO Alkalies & Chemicals Private Limited (GNAL), a Joint Venture company, has issued Compulsory Convertible Debentures (CCDs) of ₹ 500 crore carrying coupon rate at 91 days T bill plus spread of 2.03 % with quarterly reset and having tenure of 60 months. The Company and M/s. Gujarat Alkalies and Chemicals Limited (GACL), the JV partner, have entered into an arrangement of backstopping support towards repayment of principal and coupon of Compulsory Convertible Debentures (CCDs) in the proportion of their holding in the JV Company. The Company has 40% of holding in GNAL. An Option Agreement to this effect has been entered into between promoters (The Company and GACL), M/s. PNB Investment Services Ltd (Debenture Trustee) and GNAL. (issuer) wherein the sponsors (promoters) have granted mandatory put option and accelerated put option to the investor and retained accelerated buyout option and mandatory buyout option. The Deemed Investment amount of ₹ 147.36 crore which includes, ₹ 124.15 crore towards financial guarantee provided without charging any consideration from the joint venture.



The Government of Odisha vide Orissa Gazette extraordinary notification dated 31.01.2005 had notified 'Orissa Rural Infrastructure and Socio-Economic Development Act 2004 (ORISED Act)' applicable from 01.02. 2005, levying tax on mineral bearing land. 
