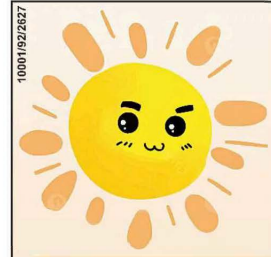

चीन में घुसने की फिराक में था फेसबुक

■ दिल्ली, नवभारत न्यूज नेटवर्क. दिग्गज टेक कंपनी फेसबुक को चीन ने बड़ा झटका दिया है. लगभग 19 हजार करोड़ रुपये का निवेश करके फेसबुक चीन में घुसने की कोशिश कर रहा था. लेकिन चीनी सरकार ने उसके अरमानों पर पानी फेर दिया है. चीन ने आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस स्टार्टअप 'मानुस' को खरीदने के लिए मेटा की प्रस्तावित दो अरब डॉलर की डील को राष्ट्रीय सुरक्षा का



हवाला देते हुए रोक दिया है. एक नई रिपोर्ट के मुताबिक, यह कदम दिखाता है कि क्रॉस-बॉर्डर टेक्नोलॉजी सौदा पर अब और सख्त निगरानी की जा रही है. मॉडर्न डिप्लोमेसी की रिपोर्ट के अनुसार चीन के नेशनल डेवलपमेंट एंड रिफॉर्म कमीशन (एनडीआरसी) ने 2021 में लागू किए गए विदेशी निवेश सुरक्षा नियमों के तहत इस डील को रोकने का आदेश दिया.

बैंक कर्जदारों को RBI ने दी बड़ी राहत

■ दिल्ली, नवभारत न्यूज नेटवर्क. भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक ने देश के बैंकों को प्राकृतिक आपदाओं से प्रभावित कर्जदारों को औपचारिक अनुरोधों की प्रतीक्षा किए बिना राहत उपाय देने की अनुमति दी है. इसके तहत बैंकों को कहा गया है कि

वे प्राकृतिक आपदाओं से प्रभावित अपने ग्राहकों को राहत देने के लिए उनके औपचारिक अनुरोध का इंतजार न करें. बैंक अब खुद से प्रभावित कर्जदारों के लिए 'रिजिलिएंस प्लान' लागू कर सकते हैं. दरअसल, आरबीआई ने खेती,

इंफ्रास्ट्रक्चर और आम लोगों की आय पर मौसम संबंधी आपदाओं के बढ़ते असर को देखते हुए यह कदम उठाया है. इसका उद्देश्य यह सुनिश्चित करना है कि किसी प्राकृतिक आपदा के समय प्रभावित लोगों को बिना कागजी कार्रवाई और बिना देरी के तुरंत वित्तीय राहत मिल सके.

Notes:

- In absence of Audit Committee, the Financial Results have been approved at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on 30th April, 2026. The annual Financial Results have been audited by the Joint Statutory Auditors of the Company as required under regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- The Company has four Joint Venture companies namely- 1. M/s. Angul Aluminium Park Pvt. Limited, 2. M/s. GACL-NALCO Alkalies & Chemicals Private Limited, 3. M/s. Khanji Bidesh India Limited, 4. M/s. Utkarsha Aluminium Dhatu Nigam Limited. Out of the four joint venture companies whose financials have been consolidated, financials of M/s. Angul Aluminium Park Pvt. Limited and M/s. GACL-NALCO Alkalies & Chemicals Private Limited have been consolidated on the basis of financials as certified by the management as on reporting date.
- Based on the recommendation of the Board, the shareholders of the Company has approved final dividend of ₹ 2.50/- per equity share (50% on face value of ₹ 5/- each) amounting to ₹ 459.16/- crore for the FY 2024-25 at 44th Annual General Meeting held on 26th September, 2025 and the same was paid on 20th October, 2025. The total dividend pay out for the FY 2024-25 is ₹ 10.50 per equity share (interim dividend of ₹ 8.00/- per share and final dividend of ₹ 2.50/- per share) amounting to ₹ 1,928.46/- crore. Interim dividend for FY 2025-26 has been paid in two tranches. The first tranche of interim dividend of ₹ 4.00 per equity share amounting to ₹ 734.65 crore was paid in December 2nd, 2025 and the second tranche of interim dividend of ₹ 4.50 per equity share amounting to ₹ 826.48 crore was paid on February 24th, 2026. With this, the total interim dividend pay-out during FY 2025-26 is ₹ 1,561.13 crore. The 3rd interim dividend of ₹ 2.00 per equity share (40% on face value of ₹ 5/- each) amounting to ₹ 367.33 crore for the FY 2025-26 has been approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 30th April, 2026.
- The Company has not recognised the revenue from its two wind power plants (WPP) located in the State of Rajasthan due to non execution of fresh Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) since 01.04.2019 and such issue is being subjecting before Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan based on writ petition filed by the Company. Similarly, due to non execution of PPA for WPP-Gandikota, Andhra Pradesh, power generated is wheeled to captive power plant at Angul, Odisha for internal consumption.
- Consequent to introduction of New Labour Codes w.e.f. 1st November 2025, pending promulgation of rules in this regard, the Company on provisional basis assessed its obligation and provided for ₹ 20.30 crore during current financial year. Further, the Company will assess additional financial implications, if any, against these codes and will account for the same, subsequent to promulgation of the related Rules.
- The Board of Directors in its meeting held on 10.04.2026 has consented for winding up/striking off of M/s. Utkarsha Aluminium Dhatu Nigam Limited, a joint venture company, the project being commercially unviable. However, clearance in this respect is pending from Ministry of Mines and Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM). The Company and Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited jointly holds 50-50 shares in the Joint Venture.
- The Board of Directors in its meeting held on 16.10.2025 has accorded its in-principle approval to increase the authorised capital of M/s. Rising Costs may Hit Local Cos: Unilever

Supply chain, input cost woes may impact smaller cos, but this will ease the intensity of competition for bigger cos: Fernando Fernandez

Mumbai: Unilever chief executive officer Fernando Fernandez said supply chain disruptions and higher crude linked input costs could hurt smaller local rivals in India, potentially easing the intensity of price competition for most large consumer goods companies in one of their fastest-growing markets. The maker of Dove soap and Surf detergent also warned that escalating geopolitical tensions and crude oil prices could raise costs across detergents and household products, particularly in emerging markets.

Fernandez, during the company's earnings call on Thursday, said its supply chain is multi-polar and very resilient.

"We are seeing some shortage in some local players, particularly in India and Southeast Asia that can support our volumes, and it will

make the passing of pricing easier in the future. We see growth opportunities in laundry powders, because we see local players, particularly in India and South Asia, Southeast Asia, being impacted in terms of availability of materials," he added.

As a result, Unilever expects the current inflationary cycle to eventually temper aggressive discounting and reduce the need for sharp price hikes by larger players, even as the company prepares calibrated increases in home and personal categories.

For the past few years, especially during the pandemic, homegrown local brands chipped away market shares from top consumer goods com-

panies through deep discounting amid lower commodity price cycle.

Unilever chief financial officer Srinivas Phatak said it gained 400 basis points of share in body wash while premium brands in personal care outperformed the Indian market. He expects local companies in India to struggle to absorb the cost pressure.

"Classically, in a

category such as home care, this actually works in our favor," Phatak said on an earnings call. "A lot of the local players get constrained both from a supply perspective as well as cash."

Phatak said about half of Unilever's inflation exposure is concentrated in homecare, with 70% of that coming from emerging markets. The company expects total inflation of ₹750 million to ₹900 million this year, assuming crude prices average about \$100 a barrel.

Unilever said pricing would rise gradually through the year, particularly in home care, but stressed it would avoid becoming uncompetitive. "There will be frequent price increases but in small doses," Phatak said. India is Unilever's second largest market by revenue and has seen premiumisation and market-share gains in detergents and body wash. The company said it has increased direct outlet coverage by about 200,000 stores and is seeing faster growth in newer channels such as quick commerce and modern trade.

The company also said newer demand drivers such as modern trade and online channels were growing faster than the broader business and contributing disproportionately to growth in India. Fernandez said the performance was not driven by a single category or temporary factor, but reflected "fewer, bigger growth bets" and improved execution across channels.

In Big Relief to Vi, Govt Pares Its AGR Liabilities by 27%

FRESH TAKE Panel finalises dues at ₹64,046 cr; move may open up avenues to raise funds

Mumbai: The department of telecommunication (DoT) has cut Vodafone Idea's (Vi's) adjusted gross revenue (AGR) liabilities by nearly 27% in a major cash-flow relief to the country's third-largest telecom operator which opens up avenues for fresh fundraising.

After reassessment of Vi's AGR dues, a DoT-appointed committee has finalised the total AGR amount at ₹64,046 crore as on December 31, 2025. Earlier, the DoT has frozen the AGR dues as on December 31, 2025 at ₹87,695 crore. The amount was, however, subject to reassessment by the DoT and final approval by the committee.

"In this regard, we now wish to submit that the DoT vide its communication dated April 30, 2026, has informed that the committee formed for the purpose has finalised the AGR dues at ₹64,046 crore as on December 31, 2025," Vi said in a regulatory filing.

Following the reduction, rival Bharti Airtel may also again write to the DoT seeking reassessment of its AGR dues. The Sunil Mittal-led telco had earlier written to DoT seeking reassessment of its AGR dues but there was no action from DoT as it felt the company should get relief order from the Supreme Court. With the AGR dues now finalized, Vi will pay a minimum of ₹100 crore annually for four years between FY32 and FY35 under the approved payment schedule.

The remaining dues will be settled in six equal annual instalments from FY36 to FY41, effectively freezing the bulk of the dues for a decade. The staggered repayments are now spread over 16 years, providing a much-needed breathing window to the struggling telco. Vi's shares closed 0.68% lower at ₹10.22 apiece on the BSE on

Thursday, before the announcement was made late evening. The government has made several interventions to keep India's third-largest telecom operator afloat.

Under the 2021 telecom relief package, the government offered a four-year moratorium to telcos, including Vi for payment of AGR and spectrum dues. The option to convert dues into equity was also given. In February 2023, nearly ₹16,000 crore of interest on deferred spectrum and AGR dues was converted into equity, giving the government about 33% stake at the time. This was followed by the conversion of an additional ₹36,950 crore of spectrum auction dues into equity in April 2025, eventually raising its stake to 48.99%, making it the company's largest shareholder.

ORS Sales Melt in April After Centre's Stricter Label Norms

New Delhi: The market for oral rehydration solutions in India has started declining, impacting pharmaceutical companies that produce them for summer consumption. Experts said the key reason could be the government's ban on labelling sugary and fruit-based drinks as ORS.

Last year, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) banned the use of the term "ORS" (oral rehydration solutions/salts) on sugary drinks and beverages. It said manufacturers must meet the WHO's norms.

Sivaranjani Santosh had filed a lawsuit and crusaded against sugary drinks that were allegedly being marketed as ORS. A favorable ruling led to withdrawal of multiple brands from the market.

According to data by PharmaTrac, value growth in the sector declined by 26% in March. In February and March this year, the value for ORS sales in India stood at ₹80 crore and ₹85 crore, respectively, down from ₹111 crore and ₹115 crore in the year-ago months.

Despite an 8% fall in the 12-month MAT (moving annual total), the ORS market stood at ₹1,128 crore, posting a CAGR of 13% over the last five years.

The segment leader, Electrol of FDC, has not been spared either, recording a MAT value decline of 7% in sales. Sheetal Sapale, vice-president, commercial, PharmaTrac, said the oral electrolytes market is showing degrowth this year. "Part of this decline needs
